- Please help your child to learn their number bonds to 10 and count up in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Please ensure that your child has a water bottle for the classroom with fresh water in it each day.
- PE for Year 1 is on Friday (indoor) and Wednesday (outdoor). Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school. Their PE kit should include a t-shirt, shorts, socks and plimsolls or trainers. Can we remind you that no jewellery is allowed and long hair should be tied back. All PE kit should be named.

If you would like to help in school as a volunteer, then please see your child's class teacher or the office staff so that police checks (DBS's) can be made and an induction arranged with Mrs Frampton.
