No other jewellery is allowed to be worn, expect medical identification jewellery• Watches are allowed but have to be removed for PE and for some curricular activities e.g. cookery. |

The children are not permitted to wear make-up, tattoos or nail varnish in school. If a child is in school wearing these we will ask the child to remove the cosmetics. If the child is unable to remove them, the school may contact their Parent/Carer and request they come into school to assist their child.

Children in receipt of free school meals will receive a voucher for a free sweatshirt or cardigan each academic year.

PE Kit: Indoors

- A plain white t-shirt
- Black shorts

PE Kit: Outdoors

- Warm jogging bottoms
- Warm long sleeved fleece or sweatshirt
- Change of footwear e.g. trainers

No football strips

Swimming Kit:

- Swimming costume (one piece for girls, no bikinis and no long shorts for boys)
- Swimming hat for boys and girls in Years 5 and 6
- No goggles

Earrings and watches must be removed for P.E. and swimming.
