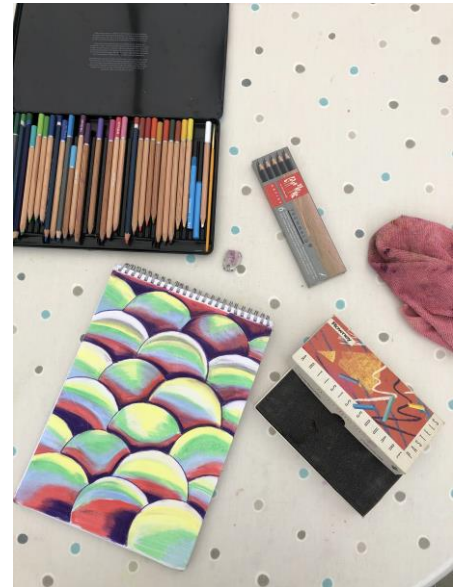


Art Challenge No. 3 – To create a repeating pattern inspired by the rainbow tribute to the NHS.

While out walking my dog, I discovered a shrine paying tribute to the NHS. Rainbows are a cheerful and colourful symbol to say thank you to the NHS for their outstanding work during the Covid19 pandemic, and it has inspired me for our next Art Challenge.



1. Find a shape you can use as a template, which is inspired by a rainbow. Be imaginative; it does not have to look exactly like a rainbow. Use objects around the house to help you. I am using a mug.



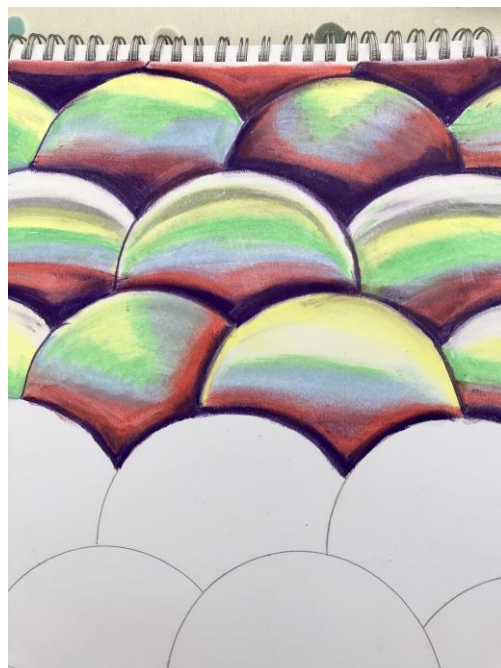
2. Use your template to draw around and create a repeating pattern.



3. Now it is time to add colour:

- You can choose any arrangements of colour you think work well together.
- You can create patterns inside the shapes.
- You can collage, use colouring pencils, paint on pebbles, or stick to pencil shading. It is up to you!

I am using a mix of pastels and colour pencil.



4. Remember Art is skilful; the more you practise, the better you will be!
