Dress Code Policy May 2020

Introduction and Purpose of Policy

- This policy is to be adhered to during the partial re-opening of Somerford Primary school due to the Coronavirus Pandemic
- Staff are expected to maintain a smart standard of casual dress and continue to present themselves in a professional manner
- Children are expected to wear appropriate clothing as outlined below.
- Final decisions about the appropriateness of dress are at the discretion of the Senior Leadership Team
- **Any child not adhering to the dress code, therefore not wearing appropriate clothes for school activities, will be sent home.**

Guidelines on Appropriate Dress

- Children do not need to wear school uniform, but can if they wish to do so.
- Shoulders must be covered (no thin straps) due to spending time outside.
- Suitable sports footwear must be worn, such as trainers, or flat shoes. No heels.
- Children must bring a hat on sunny days.
- Children must not wear make-up.
- No inappropriate logos should be worn.
- Children must not wear onesies or fancy dress.
- Children should not wear crop tops

Additional Guidelines

- Children will not need to change into a PE kit but must be prepared to engage in sporting activities therefore it is essential that appropriate clothing is worn every day.
- Clothing must be washed each evening after school.
- Should the school fully reopen, all children will be expected to wear the correct school uniform.
- The dress code and policy will be reviewed should circumstances change during the partial opening.
