Live Streaming

We have had some concerns about children in our school 'live streaming' on apps and websites. The Safer Schools and Community Team from Dorset Police advise that children do not engage in this but if they do, the webcam or device is in a shared area of the house and they are supervised by an adult at all times.

Whilst this can be seen as a fun thing to take part in, unfortunately there have been many incidents of this going wrong. Children can be groomed or pressurised to stream inappropriate things and often on these sites other people are live streaming inappropriate things themselves. There have also been some incidences of online bullying via live streaming.

Please discuss these risks with your child and ensure they understand how to be safe online. More information can be found on the NSPCC website.
