The end of KS2 SATs results this year show Somerford is a rapidly improving school:

Reading - 13% increase from 2018

Maths – 17% increase from 2018

Spelling, punctuation and grammar – 24% increase from 2018 Reading, writing and maths combined – 21% increase from 2018

The children are also making us proud in their other areas of learning too – those which are not measured by end of year tests. We are proud to have been awarded the Gold Sports Mark for our enhanced PE and Sport provision, children in KS2 have had their writing published in a book, Y4 and Y6 pushed themselves and proved their resilience and perseverance on their residentials andso much more!

We wish our Y6s the very best of luck as they move on to their secondary schools. We know they are ready for this next adventure and can't wait to hear about their achievements.

We also have some other leavers on Tuesday and we wish them the very best at their new schools.

To the rest of you, I wish you a relaxing, healthy and sunny summer, and look forward to working with you again when we return on 3rd September.

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
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Children's workbooks
