In your team's classroom, you will have your own desk to sit at every day.

On your desk, you will have a labelled pack that includes all the equipment you need to do your work so that you won't have to share anything with anyone else in the bubble!

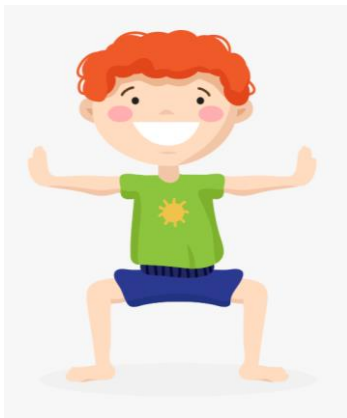


Break Time

has its own area to play in.



You will not need to wear your school uniform but you will need to wear clean, sensible clothes every day.



Your grown-ups at home will make sure that they wash your clothes regularly to keep them nice and clean.

You will be going outside a lot so you should wear trainers or shoes that are really comfortable and easy to run in.



Because there is a virus around we will be washing our hands a lot more to help keep everyone safe.

There will be posters to remind you how to wash your hands and for how long.



Each team will have its own set of toilets which means that some toilets will be used by boys and girls but you will only be allowed to use the toilets one at a time.



It will be lovely to be back in school and see our friends again, but we must remember to try to keep a little bit away from each other.

We can still be friends even if we don't touch.
