




Staying Safe **Answers**







There may be more hazards than those circled.

Scenario 1: The Street

- Litter on the road may be sharp or a trip hazard.
- The dog is not wearing a lead and may bite.
- Cars are driving along the street.

Scenario 2: The Classroom

- Sharp scissors are on the floor.
- The fallen chair may be a trip hazard.
- The drink on the table may still be hot.
