Dear Parents and Carers

Yesterday, Gavin Williamson, Secretary of Sate for Education, made an announcement that the government's plan to welcome back children in Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 has changed. Only schools with capacity to bring these children back are now being asked to.

With class sizes remaining capped at 15 and the protective measures for schools remaining the same, unfortunately, at Somerford, we do not have any additional capacity to welcome back any other year groups before the summer holidays.

I understand that to many of you and your children this is very disappointing – it is for us too. We truly miss all of our school family who remain at home however, the safety of children, staff and parents must be our primary concern.

We would like to offer your child an opportunity to feel more connected to their class and teacher via a Zoom meeting next week. This will not be a lesson but an opportunity to see each other, ask questions and have some fun. If successful we may hold more sessions for the class to meet up.

I have attached some online safety rules – please make sure you read them with your child and adhere to them during the meeting.

The log on details for the Zoom meeting will be sent closer to the time.
