Dear Parents and Carers

I wanted to write you about Christmas!

We have worked hard to ensure children can still learn the Christmas story, enjoy the magic of Christmas and celebrate this important festival in a safe way. It will mean some changes however and I would appreciate your support with this.

Decorations

Classes will spend some time tomorrow afternoon decorating their classrooms and bubble areas. We cannot allow any decorations to be brought in from home.

Christmas cards

We will be allowing children to bring in Christmas cards for their friends. These must be clearly labelled with a name and class. All cards **must** be posted in to the school post boxes. This will allow them to be in 'quarantine' before they are handed out. All cards must be in the post boxes by 11th December. They will be handed out on 16th December.

Christmas lunch

Lunch for KS2 will be on 16th December and lunch for KS1 will be on 15th December. If you would like your child to have a lunch this must be ordered on line. Children will eat their lunch in their bubbles as they currently do. Children having a Christmas lunch will be given a cracker. If you do not want your child to have a cracker, please let your child's class teacher know.

A visit from the elves

We have heard that the elves who have visited us they last few years will be coming again and this time will bring some friends with them so each class can have an elf for December. Sadly, Father Christmas has told us these elves will not be able to travel to children's homes this year and instead will stay in the classrooms.

Christmas story

Each day in December, there will be an assembly and these will discuss Advent and the Christmas story. Some of these assemblies will be led by Mrs Frampton and Mr Wallace. Some of them will be led by Sam Pink from God First Church who regularly delivers assemblies in the school. Classes will also be studying the Christmas story in their RE lessons.

Christmas performance

We are unable to hold our usual KS1 nativity performances or our KS2 carol service in The Priory. Instead, each class will be recording a short Christmas performance which we intend to share digitally with you either via YouTube or a more private platform such as Teams. In order to do this, and include all children, we need your permission to record and share your child's image in such a video. Please complete and return the slip below to give this permission. Unfortunately, if we do not receive your permission by 7th December, your child will not be able to appear in the final video. They will still be involved in the fun of rehearsals.

Christmas jumper day

On Friday 11th December we will be holding a Christmas jumper day in aid of Save the Children. Mrs Cook has sent a letter with more details.
