COVID reminders

Thank you to all parents who have supported school by adhering to the guidelines for isolation and for informing us of any suspected or confirmed cases. This has meant we have not had to close any bubbles and the risk at school has remained low. We could not manage that without everyone's support of the 'rules'. A couple of reminders:

• If you or your children have symptoms you must stay at home whilst you seek testing and until the result is confirmed. This is already helping to reduce the need for any children to self-isolate as contacts and miss out on school. Thank you!

• If the school was to be notified of a positive case and the person had been in school during their infectious period, the school would work very closely with Public Health and the Local Authority to identify any children or staff who would then be asked to self-isolate for 14 days. The school will communicate with parents of affected children directly using Marvellous ME.

• We really appreciate all the efforts families make to adhere to guidelines—hands, face, space.

There will no family group or sibling photos this year.
