EDUCAMPS – HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES AND FOOD PROGRAMME

Our programme includes archery, bushcrafts, Nerf Wars, climbing wall, crate stacking, inflatable obstacle course and slide and much more. We also have wet afternoons where at the end of each day the children can have water bomb wars and play on water slides.

Half day and full day sessions are available and we have also included for summer 2021 a full week overnight experience sleeping in a wooden lodge. All children are provided with a cooked lunch daily and breakfast evening meal if staying overnight.

All staff are trained to a minimum of Level 1 safeguarding and hold an enhanced DBS certificate. We also have a Designated and trained DSL and some staff members are qualified in SEN support.

All activities are designed to bring children together so they can challenge themselves with new experiences and tasks involving team building and communication. The benefits of our camps is increased confidence, independence, activity and exercise in a rural back to basics setting with the opportunity to interact with other children and develop friendships.

All policies procedures and risk assessments are in place to include safeguarding, COVID secure, health and safety and Food and Hygiene.
