MATERIALS



WOOD

It is a natural material found in trees.



METAL

It is a natural material that is found in the ground.



PLASTIC

Plastic is a man-made material.



STONE

It is a natural material that is found in the ground.



LEATHER

It is a natural material made from animals.



RUBBER

Some rubbers are natural and others are man-made.

NATURAL:

Natural materials come from plants, animals or the ground.



MAN-MADE:

Man-made materials are created by humans.



KEY VOCABULARY



TRANSPARENT: a material that allows light to pass through



FRAGILE: an object that can be easily dam aged or broken.



OPAQUE: a material that doesn't allow light to pass through it so you cannot see the objects behind it.



FLEXIBLE: an object that is able to bend easily without breaking.



TRANSLUCENT: a material that allows some light to pass through.



RIGID: an object that is unable to bend or to be forced out of shape.
