






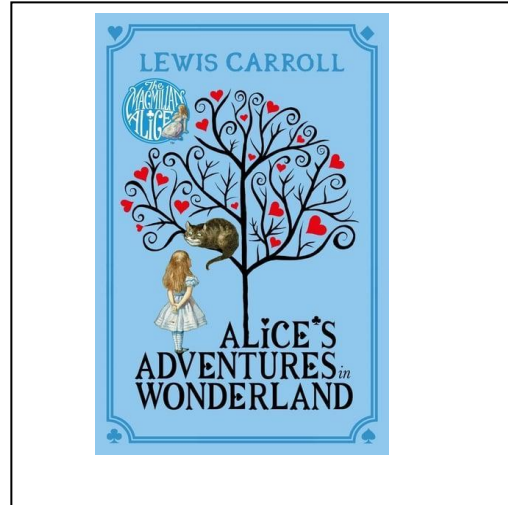


Alice in Wonderland Knowledge Organiser- Year Two
