Review of COVID arrangements

As you know, we reviewed our additional COVID measures at the end of October. Unfortunately at this time, we had a significant number of cases and we had to in fact increase our measures for a short time.

We have reviewed them again this week and we are continuing to have some cases in school and the numbers in BCP continue to rise as you can see:

Cases in Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole

A confirmed case is someone who has tested positive for coronavirus. 240 new people had a confirmed positive test result reported on 18 October 2021. Between 12 October 2021 and 18 October 2021, 1,603 people had a confirmed

positive test result. This shows an increase of 46.1% compared to the previous 7 days. <u>Simple summary - Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole | Coronavirus in the UK (data.gov.uk)</u> The numbers are also increasing across the South West and Public Health have

The numbers are also increasing across the South West and Public Health have advised all schools to maintain or increase our measures.

In the light of this advise and the winter period approaching, we will be maintaining some of our additional measures including staggered starts and ends to the day with no parents on site in order to limit the number of adults on site. I have had lots of positive feedback from parents about these arrangements and I am sure many will be pleased they are remaining for the moment. I am aware however, that if your child's gate is not the most convenient, you may be disappointed by this. Please remember we are just trying to keep everyone as safe as

we can. Please talk to your child's class teacher if you wish to discuss these arrangements for your child.
