Uniform

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Our focus for this year

This year we are focussing on 3 key areas to make our school even better:

-ensuring we have the highest expectations for children, parents and staff
-increasing children's independence
-developing children's resilience in their learning

We will be talking to children about these areas in class and in assemblies and the School Improvement Plan will be available on the school website soon.

Within these areas we are particularly working on improving writing and attendance.

Attendance

Our expectation for attendance is 96% or above.

Children need to be in school every day and on time to ensure the best chance of them reaching their potential.

The government has released new guidance on attendance work in schools and our Attendance Policy is being updated and will be shared with you when approved by the Governors.

Please remember that where possible, medical appointments should be made out of school time and the school will not authorise leave in term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Holidays are not considered exceptional circumstances and are likely to result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued to each parent for each child.

Attendance at the end of this week

Whole school: 94.9%

Year 1: 91.1%

Year 2: 96.3%

Year 3: 100%

Year 4: 93.1%

Year 5: 94.4%

Year 6: 94.7%

That means across the whole school, children have missed a total of 47 days learning already!
