Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to the Autumn Term of 2022-2023. What a year it is going to be. We are very proud of the children for how well they have settled back into school and how quickly they have adapted to the new systems and structures in place. They should all feel very proud of themselves too.

This term, we have started with the topic 'it's All Greek To Me'. We will start by studying the history of The Ancient Greek civilisation and then we will move on to exploring the human and physical geography of modern-day Greece and compare it to how it has changed since Ancient Greek times.

As part of our learning, the children will be discovering important facts and information, which you will find on the Knowledge Organisers that have been sent home already. The children will become extremely familiar with the Knowledge Organisers as we will be using them regularly in class. It would be wonderful if you could also continue this learning at home by asking questions about their topic, based on the facts found on the Knowledge Organisers. The children love to play games with them, such as "How many facts can you recall in a minute" or "Fastest Finger – Who can find a particular fact the quickest?"

Our PE days this term are Wednesday (Outdoor) and Friday (Indoor). Your child should come to school dressed in their PE Kit for the whole day. Please ensure that they are wearing kit in line with the school policy (plain white top, black/blue shorts or jogging bottoms, trainers) and that they have jogging bottoms and a warm top when the weather is colder.
