School Uniform Policy

Aims

The aims of the school's uniform policy are to:

- Foster a sense of pride and corporate identity.
- Support a sense of belonging, equality and dignity.
- Provide affordable durable clothing.
- Provide financial assistance for families experiencing difficulty.

Smart grey or black skirt or pinafore dress White polo shirt (with school logo optional) Summer dresses in royal blue and white gingham Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo Black low heeled shoes, no crocs Earrings are discouraged, so only one small stud is allowed in each ear and these must be removed for PE. No other jewellery is allowed to be worn, expect medical identification jewellery Watches are allowed but have to be removed for PE and for some curricular activities e.g. cookery.

The children are not permitted to wear make-up, tattoos or nail varnish in school. If a child is in school wearing these we will ask the child to remove the cosmetics. If the child is unable to remove them, the school may contact their Parent/Carer and request they come into school to assist their child.

Affordability

To ensure the school uniform is affordable, the following measures are in place: Children in receipt of free school meals will receive a voucher for a free sweatshirt or cardigan each academic year.

- White polo shirts can be purchased without the school logo, which is optional.
- There is only one item of school uniform which requires the logo, the royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Second-hand uniform sales are held at the end of the school year and throughout the year as required.
- We ensure that our school wear company provides good quality products at value for money prices.

PE Kit: Indoors

- A plain white t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Elastic fronted plimsolls or trainers No football strips.

PE Kit: Outdoors

- Warm black jogging bottoms
- Warm, plain long sleeved fleece or sweatshirt
- Trainers

No football strips

Swimming Kit:

- Swimming costume (one piece swimsuit, no bikinis and no long shorts)
- Swimming hat for children in Years 5 and 6

Earrings and watches must be removed for P.E. and swimming.
