Christmas pop up shop – all is free

Come along to the school hall on Friday 9th December 1.45-2.45 to pick up some useful items for Christmas. Tracy Blick from Christchurch Foodbank will also be available to chat to.

Christchurch Foodbank

All children in receipt of benefit related free school meals will receive a voucher from the Foodbank for Christmas. The Foodbank can help with many things other than food too so contact them if you are struggling. Call 07587371088 or 07536983678. The school can provide Foodbank vouchers at any time of the year – just ask.

Household Support Fund- Food Vouchers for the December School Holiday

Food vouchers will be available for all parents with children who are registered for benefit related free school meals. The value of the voucher will be £15 per child for a week, so £30 per child for the two weeks holidays. This will be issued as usual on the 19th December.

Free holiday club with a 2 course lunch

Premier Education are running a holiday club in the first week of the holidays which is free to children in receipt of free school meals. Children receive a cooked lunch with pudding each day too. Book on with the link sent on Mme. If you need help accessing this, please ask.

Household Support Fund 3

This funding is to support residents in BCP with the cost of living situations around keeping warm, reducing energy bills and accessing food across the winter.

Residents can apply for short term financial help through food and/or energy vouchers through Citizen's Advice BCP at Household Support Fund - Citizens Advice Bournemouth Christchurch & Poole (citizensadvicebcp.org.uk).
