Attendance

Our expectation for attendance is 96% or above.

Children need to be in school every day and on time to ensure the best chance of reaching their potential.

Please remember that where possible, medical appointments should be made out of school time and the school will not authorise leave in term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Holidays are not considered exceptional circumstances and are likely to result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued to each parent for each child.

Attendance at the end of this week

Whole school: 93% compared to 93.5% nationally

Year 1: 93.7% (93.2 nationally) Year 2: 93.9% (93.9 nationally) Year 3: 95.0% (94.2 nationally) Year 4: 91.9% (94.2% nationally) Year 5: 92.2% (94.1% nationally) Year 6: 92.5% (93.9 nationally)

Our analysis shows that boys attendance is lower than girls—so **if you are a boy in** Year 4, 5 or 6, we really need you in school every day!

Changes to gates and times for Y1

From after Easter, 17 April, we will no longer be using the back gate. This means Year 1 will enter and leave from the front gate from 17 April. It also means NO children will be able to enter or leave from the back gate and everyone will need to use the front gate.

The timings for Y1 will change slightly.

From 17 April, Y1 will start at 8.50am and leave at 3.15pm.
