PE Uniform

Children in Y2-6 come to school in their PE kit on their PE days.

Children in Reception and Year 1 need to bring their kit in a bag and leave it at school. They will change in school to help them practice getting dressed and undressed independently.

PE kit consists of plain black shorts or joggers and a white t shirt. Your child can wear their school jumper or cardigan as an extra layer. Hoodies are not allowed.

Please remember any long hair must be tied up for PE and all jewellery must be removed, including earrings. If your child cannot remove these independently, we suggest they do not wear them on PE days.

If your child has recently had their ears pierced they can bring in tape or a plaster to cover them for the initial few weeks.
