

Top tips for staying safe online

- 1 Passwords should be **strong and secret** try using three random words or use a password manager.
- 2 Keep your personal information and photos private.
- 3 Look for the padlock in the address bar this means the website is secure.
- 4 If you see something inappropriate, **block** the sender and **report** the content. Don't reshare!
- 5 Keep devices updated with the latest security updates.
- 6 Don't open or download files from unknown senders.
- 7 Use 2-step verification to make it harder for others to access your accounts.
- 8 Use a **password**, **pin**, **or pattern** on your devices to keep others out.
- 9 Beware of requests for personal information.
- 10 If something doesn't seem right, talk to someone you trust.
