<u>Full Fact</u> – this fact checking website has compiled a range of articles highlighting the role of misinformation in the summer riots.

<u>Snopes</u> – this fact-checking tool verifies news and social media rumours. Some articles contain mature themes, so it is advised to preview content.





<u>Thinking Critically Online</u> – these interactive resources for years 5 and 6 aged children explore the differences between belief, fact and opinion.
