Summer holiday food vouchers

The Council have announced they will be issuing food vouchers for the summer holidays again this year through school if your child is registered for benefit related free school meals.

This year the vouchers will be worth **£70** in total for the summer holidays for each eligible child. This is less than the previous £15 per week and will equate to about \pounds 11.66 per week per child.

Vouchers will be issued from 10th July and you will receive an email or message when they have been sent out.
