Last week, Somerford hosted the first in our new series of Parent Workshops, led by Mr Thorne (SENCO) and Mrs Macmillan (Senior Mental Health & Pastoral Lead).

The session explored what neurodiversity means – that every brain works in its own unique way – and how understanding these differences can help children learn, grow and feel confident both at home and in school. Parents took away practical ideas and a new way of seeing their children's strengths and challenges.

Every child is different and these workshops are about understanding and supporting your child in the best way possible. These sessions are also a great way for parents to get to know each other and share ideas and there will be tea and coffee and biscuits.

Future workshops will look at everyday support at home, school and learning, and emotions and behaviour.
