SCIENCE	- Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat - Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement
PSHE	- Identify when it is appropriate or inappropriate to allow someone into their body space (personal space) - Know who they could ask for help if a secret made them feel uncomfortable or unsafe - Recognise that babies come from the joining of an egg and sperm - Understand that for girls, periods are a normal part of puberty

COMPUTING	- Identify different types of data organisation including graphs, charts, maps, diagrams and databases - Use yes / no questions to sort data - Create a simple branching database using software
DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY	- Understand and use electrical systems in their products [for example, series circuits incorporating switches, bulbs, buzzers and motors] - Use simple circuits to make movement or light - Join materials using permanent and temporary fixings - Add a mechanical element to a model following instructions, switches, bulbs and motors
GEOGRAPHY	- Name the layers that make up the Earth - Name the key parts of a volcano - Describe a tsunami - Explain why earthquakes occur

MFL	- Name some food items <i>un fromage</i> (cheese,) <i>un gâteau</i> (cake,) <i>une glace</i> (icecream) - Name members of my family: <i>Mon père</i> (father), <i>Ma mère</i> (mother), <i>Ma soeur</i> (sister), <i>Mon frère</i> (brother) - Say if I have brothers and sisters. Ask someone if they have brothers or sisters
MUSIC	- Play in the key of F major and D major - Understand the time signature 3/4 -there are 3 beats in a bar - Know how to create accompaniments for tunes - Know how to use musical words to describe what I like and do not like about a piece of music
PE	Rounders - Develop their ability to keep the batter's score as low as possible by applying accurate throwing, catching and retrieving skills Golf - Throw the ball and/or strike the ball using the Roller (Putter) accurately, sending the ball to the intended target
RE	- Say who Brahman is - Say some of the different forms of Brahman. - Describe what a Hindu might believe about one of the Hindu gods and start to understand that Brahman is in everything.
