

	ESSENTIAL KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS
SCIENCE	- Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. - Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes. - Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
PSHE	- Understand and explain the outcomes of risk-taking in a given situation, including emotional risks. - Recognise that some situations can be made less risky e.g. only sharing information with someone you trust. - Describe how the five ways to wellbeing contribute to a healthy lifestyle, giving examples of how they can be implemented in people's lives.
ART AND DESIGN	- Know the artist Banksy - Experiment with making stencils and printing block colour and overlaying colour.
COMPUTING	- Present research on game types to inform planning. - Use Scratch or Kodu to create a simple game. - Design appropriate advertising materials to launch or promote a product.
