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Safeguarding Concern

We have been made aware that several titles in the 'According to Humphrey' series contain a weblink at the back of the book that no longer directs people to information about the books. Instead, the link has been compromised and now leads to inappropriate and unsafe material that should not be accessed by children at any age.

Below are images of some of the front covers in the series to help you identify the books should you have any at home. The link can be found on the back cover or may be also included on a page inside.

For clarity and reassurance, we are not aware of any children who have accessed this link at our school and have removed copies of the book with the weblink from school circulation.

Actions and Next Steps:

- If you have any of these books at home, we advise you to remove them immediately or remove the page with the weblink.
- Be extra-vigilant with all children's books that contain links and ensure that they are checked by an adult.

We are grateful for your continued support in working together to keep our children safe.



Cycle safety advice from Safer Schools & Communities Team

The shorter days and hazardous winter weather pose increased risks when cycling, especially on the roads. It is paramount that those who regularly ride a bicycle, whether that be commuting to school or in their own time, are aware of the steps they need to take to ensure that they keep themselves, and those around them, safe.

We advise that, during these winter months, cyclists ALWAYS wear **fluorescent clothing** and attach a **red rear light** and **white front light** to their bicycles to ensure maximum visibility. Attaching **reflectors** is also advised. Cyclists **must obey all road signs and signals** and ensure they are practicing **safe road positioning**.
